



REDEEMER SEMINARY

50% and 25% Scholarships

Redeemer Seminary is awarding scholarships for students in the M.Div., M.A.R., or M.A. programs of study. The scholarship is for 50 percent of tuition taken as a full time student, or 25% as a part time student, in all courses taken in any term: Summer, Fall, Winter and Spring. Applications can be received at any time prior to the entering term. In any financial aid calculation, scholarships awarded by Redeemer should be considered the last source of educational funding, after personal, family, friend, church, or other aid.

Eligibility:

1. Enrolled in a program of full time study taking at least 12 semester hours each Fall/Spring, or as a part time student taking 1-11 semester hours.
2. Maintain a 2.5 or higher G.P.A. throughout the student's seminary career
3. Meet one of the following criteria:
 - a. RUF internship completed or RUF student with RUF Campus Minister recommendation.
 - b. Documented involvement in church or para-church ministry.
 - c. Documented involvement in and/or commitment to International Missions
 - d. Documented involvement in and/or commitment to Church Planting.
 - e. Documented involvement in process leading to ordained gospel ministry.
 - f. Documented potential for significant ministry leadership.

2. Submit a resume which includes information about your ministry involvement.
3. Submit an essay of no longer than two pages (12 point font, Times New Roman, one inch margins, single spaced) stating your reasons for choosing Redeemer — including the circumstances affecting your decision to come to seminary, your documented involvement corresponding to the eligibility criteria noted above, vision for future ministry, and a description of how your current ministry aligns with your vision for future ministry.
